
# Annual Report 2016

Assisting working and rescued Equines, Camels, Elephants, Bullocks, Monkeys and Dogs

- **1. Afghanistan Nowzad** Sponsorship program. Total Donkeys Sponsored: 4 [ \$600 x 4 = 2400 p/a]
- **2.** Egypt- Egyptian Society of Animal Friends [ESAF] Pyramid and Village Medical and Feed Clinics. [ $$1500 \times 4 = $6000 \text{ p/a}$ ] Gifts that Give \$705 [Wormers, nose bands and fly masks]
- **3.** India- Friendicoes Sponsorship Program, Gifts that Give Program \$433[ Harness padding and Medical treatments], Mobile Medical Clinics and Para-vet Program. Total Equines Sponsored:  $10 [10 \times 600 = $6000 + $1800 \text{ mobile clinics } \times 4 = $7200$ . Expenditure for para vet program will be shown in 2017 financial records [\$10,000] Medical equipment: \$423.59
- **4.** India- The Asswin Program- Sponsorship Program and donation of medical supplies and equipment via direct delivery by volunteers. Total Equipment via  $1 = 600 \times 1 = 600$
- **5.** India Help in Suffering- Camel Rescue Program- Sponsorship Program, Gifts that Give Program \$250 [ Camel Reflectors and plastic nose pegs], Mobile Camel Clinics, Large Animal Rescue Vehicle [ donated]. Total Camels Sponsored: 3 [  $$600 \times 3 = $1800 \text{ p/a} + \text{mobile clinics} $1500 \times 4 = $6,000$ ]
- **6. India- Hope and Animal** Sponsorship Program- Rescued security/guard dogs [ cannot be released back on the streets]. Total dogs sponsored:  $6 [\$300 \times 6 = \$1800 \text{ p/a}]$
- 7. India- Animal Rahat Sponsorship Program rescued/retired working bullocks. Total bullocks sponsored:  $3 [\$600 \times 3 = \$1800 \text{ p/a}]$
- **8. Israel- Pegasus** Sponsorship Program and assistance with feed and rescue costs. Total equines sponsored:  $5 [\$600 \times 5 = \$3000 + \text{feed}]$  and rescue costs  $\$1500/\$2000 \times 4 = \$8000$
- **9.** Indonesia- Gili Eco Trust Gili Island Rubbish horses- Feed and equipment. [ $$1000 \times 4 = $4000 \text{ p/a}$ ] Harnesses [ $9 \times $220 = $1980 + \text{Medical supplies }$127.96$ ] Gifts that Give: \$440 [Harnesses]
- **10.** Indonesia Animal Friends Jogja [AFJ] Monkey Rehab of street performing monkeys [ $$1500 \times 4 = $6000$ ] Funds cover food, training and enrichment program in readiness for release. Gifts that Give: \$70 [Vet Nurse Salary]
- 11. Kurdistan- Kurdistan Organisation of Animal Rights and Protection [ KOARP] Fund medical clinics to assist equines and other farm animals includes shepherd dogs. [ $$1500 \times 1 = $1500$ ] Started funding this program in Nov 2016.
- **12. Nepal- Animal Nepal** Sponsorship Program, Nirvana Trekking Horses [ Pokhara], Gifts that Give Program \$615 [ Feed a donkey and Rescue a donkey]. Total equines sponsored:  $19 [19 \times $600 = $11,400 \text{ p/a}]$
- **13.** Pakistan- SAYVET Medical Clinics to assist equines and camels. This program resumed in Oct 2016. [ $$2000 \times 1 = $2000$ ]
- **14.** Romania- Save the Dogs and Other Animals Sponsorship Program and Outreach Clinics. Total horses sponsored:  $5 [$600 \times 5 =$3000 \text{ p/a} + \text{Outreach Clinics} $1000 \times 1 = $1000]$ . Outreach clinic program started Oct 2016
- **15. Sri Lanka Bridging Lanka** Mannar Donkey Program- Donkey welfare program. [ $$1500 \times 4 = $6000 \text{ p/a}$ ]
- **16. Somaliland Somaliland Animal Welfare Society** [SAWS] Outreach Medical Clinics for donkeys. [ $$2000 \times 4 = $8,000 \text{ p/a}$ ]
- **17.** Tanzania Tanzania Animal Welfare Society [TAWSO] Outreach Medical Clinics for donkeys [ $$1000 \times 2 = $2000$ ]. Outreach program conducted in August and December.

**18.** Tanzania - Meru Animal Welfare Organisation [MAWO] Johnson Liyomo - Outreach Medical Clinics for donkeys, Water Carts [\$2000 x 4 = \$8000 + Carts - 2 x \$200 = \$400] **19.** Tanzania - Tanzania Animal Welfare Organisation [TAWO] — Outreach Medical Clinics for donkeys and training of para-vets. [\$1500 x 1 = \$1500] This program started in Nov 2016. **20.** Thailand - Wildlife Friends for Thailand [WFFT] - Sponsorship Program for elephants. Total sponsored: 13 + 1 [Khao Khun in Laos] [14 x \$600 = \$8400]

NB: Noahs Ark – Malaysia. We donated \$1000 to this group as they were going thru some financial difficulties with a group split. Funds were to assist with feed costs for 7 horses and 2 ponies They soon found their feet and we were no longer needed [ Program lasted 3 mths]


Took on two new partner groups in 2016- TAWO in Tanzania and KOARP in Kurdistan

#### Main 2016 Achievements

Fund new par-vet program in India with Friendicoes to fund 2 new par-vets and 2 motor bikes to service outlying areas of New Delhi to work in collaboration with mobile outreach clinics. Funded through a grant of \$10,000 from Australian Ethical.

\$10,000 in 60 days' campaign to fund equipment and medicines for our partner groups. Very successful with total raised before deadline. Thanks to Kaylene Idda for setting up this campaign.

HIS Camel Rescue Centre large Animal Rescue Vehicle finally in operation 50 % funded by AAA. Remaining amount funded by The Kindness Trust.
